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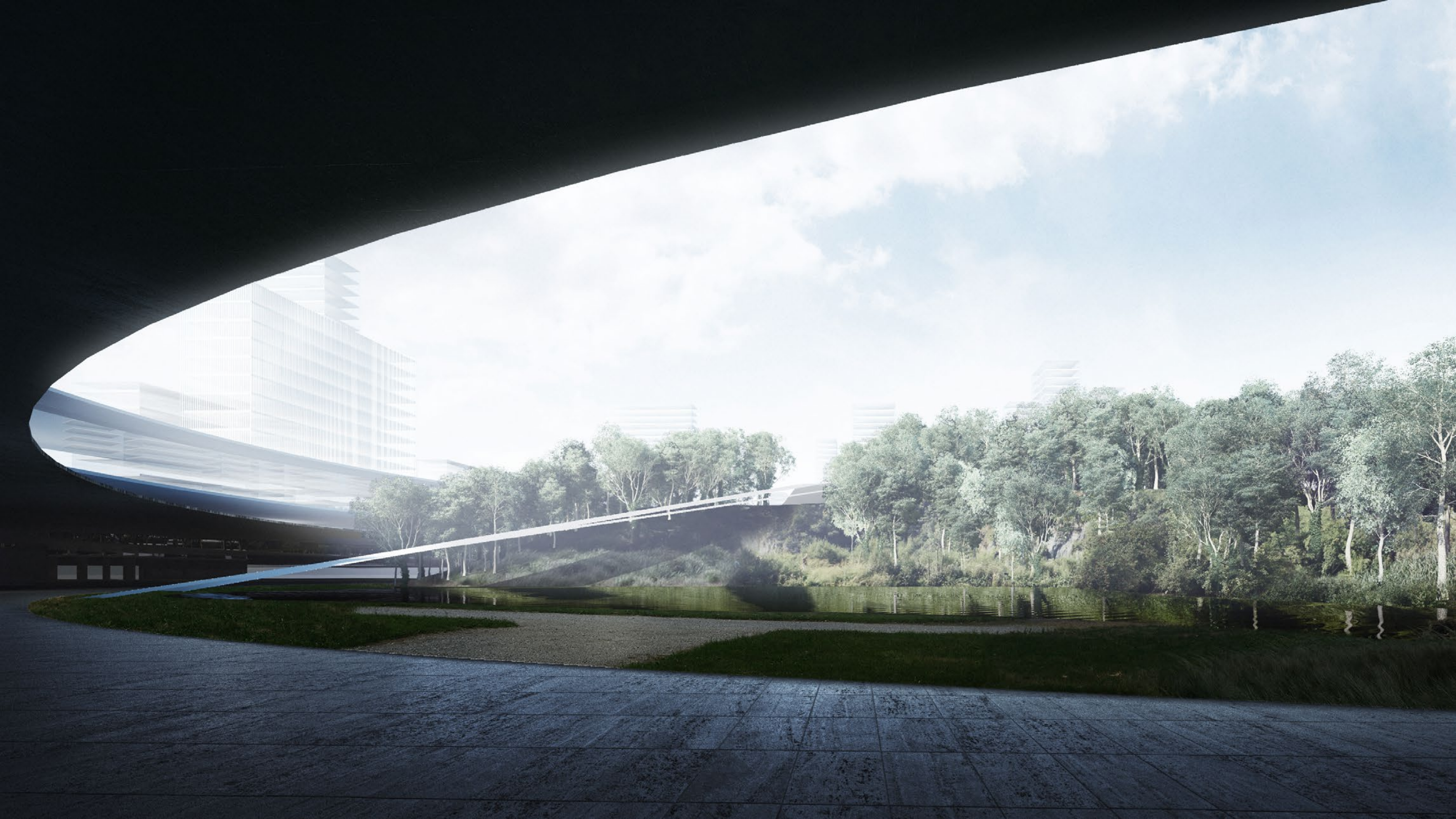

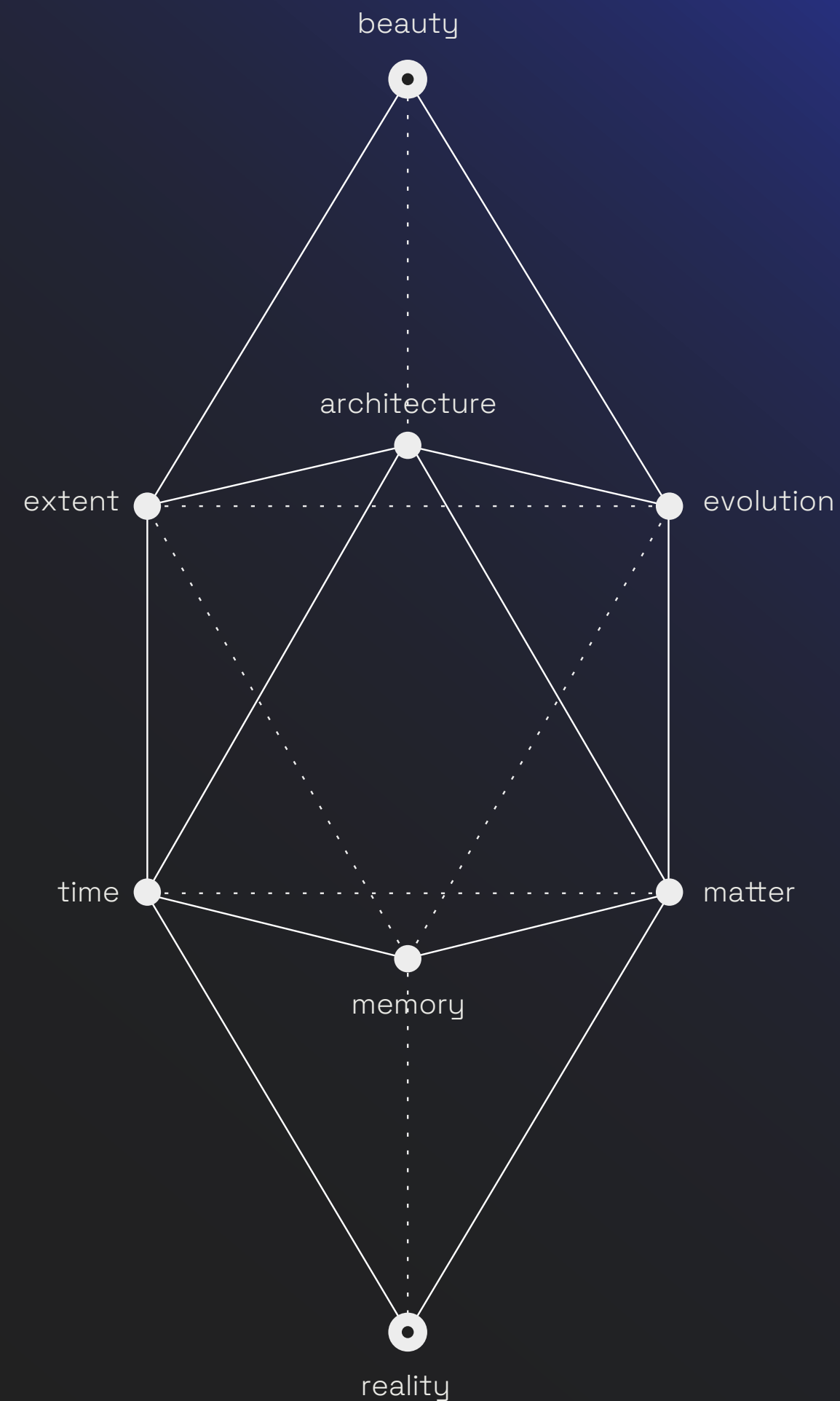

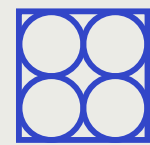
For us, architecture is not just about aesthetics; it is an act of social and environmental transformation.

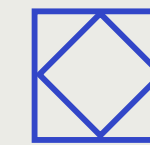

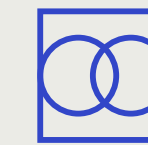

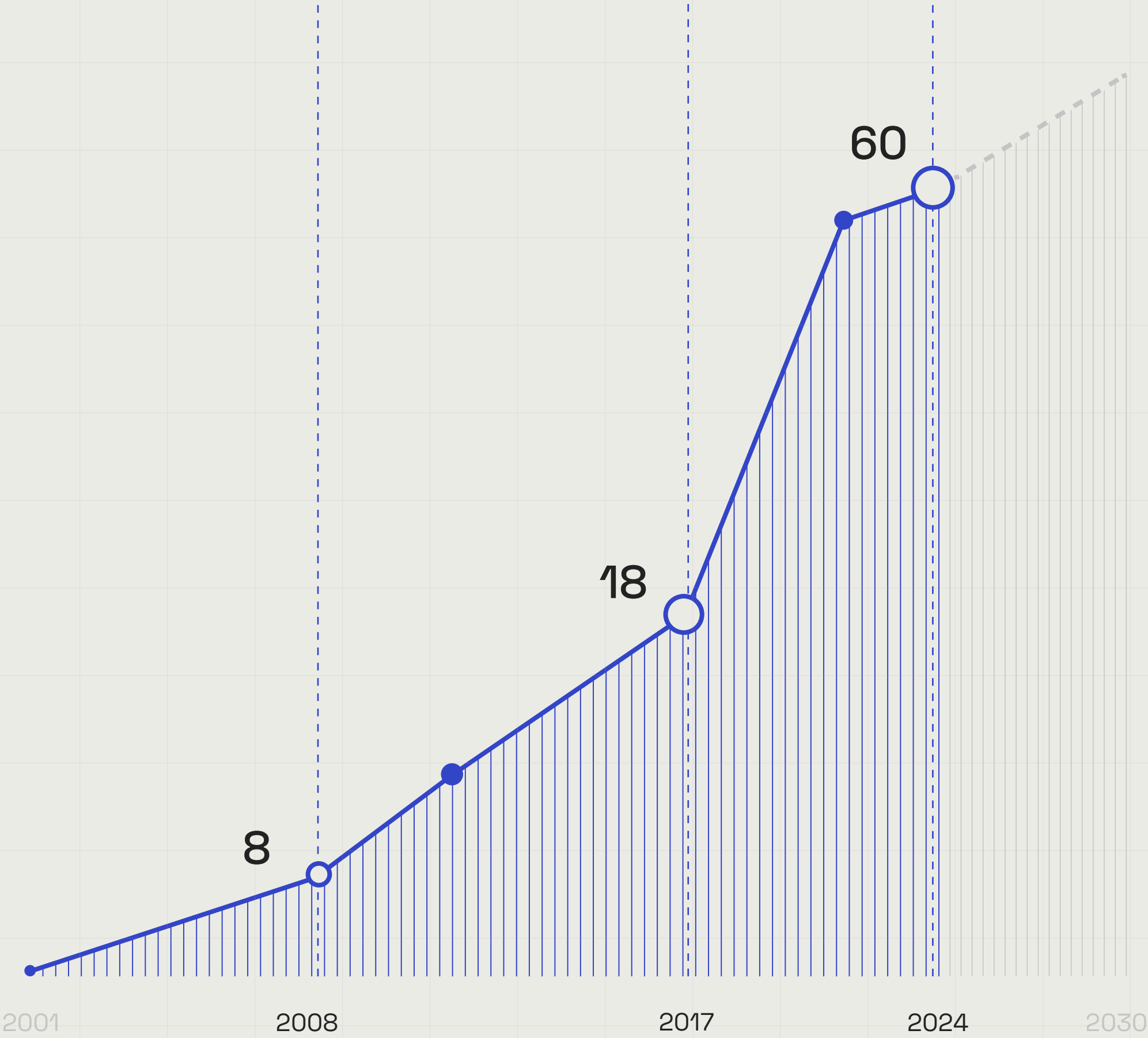
In almost 25 years of activity, the firm has experienced steady growth, expanding its expertise and diversifying its projects.

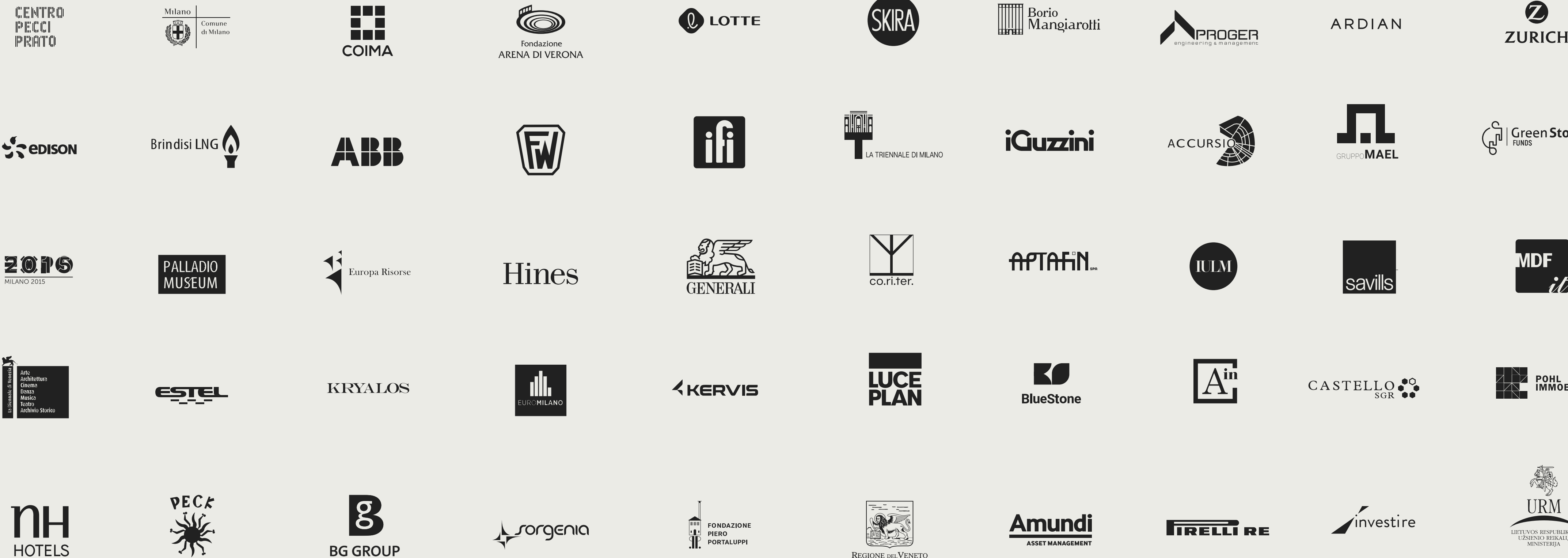

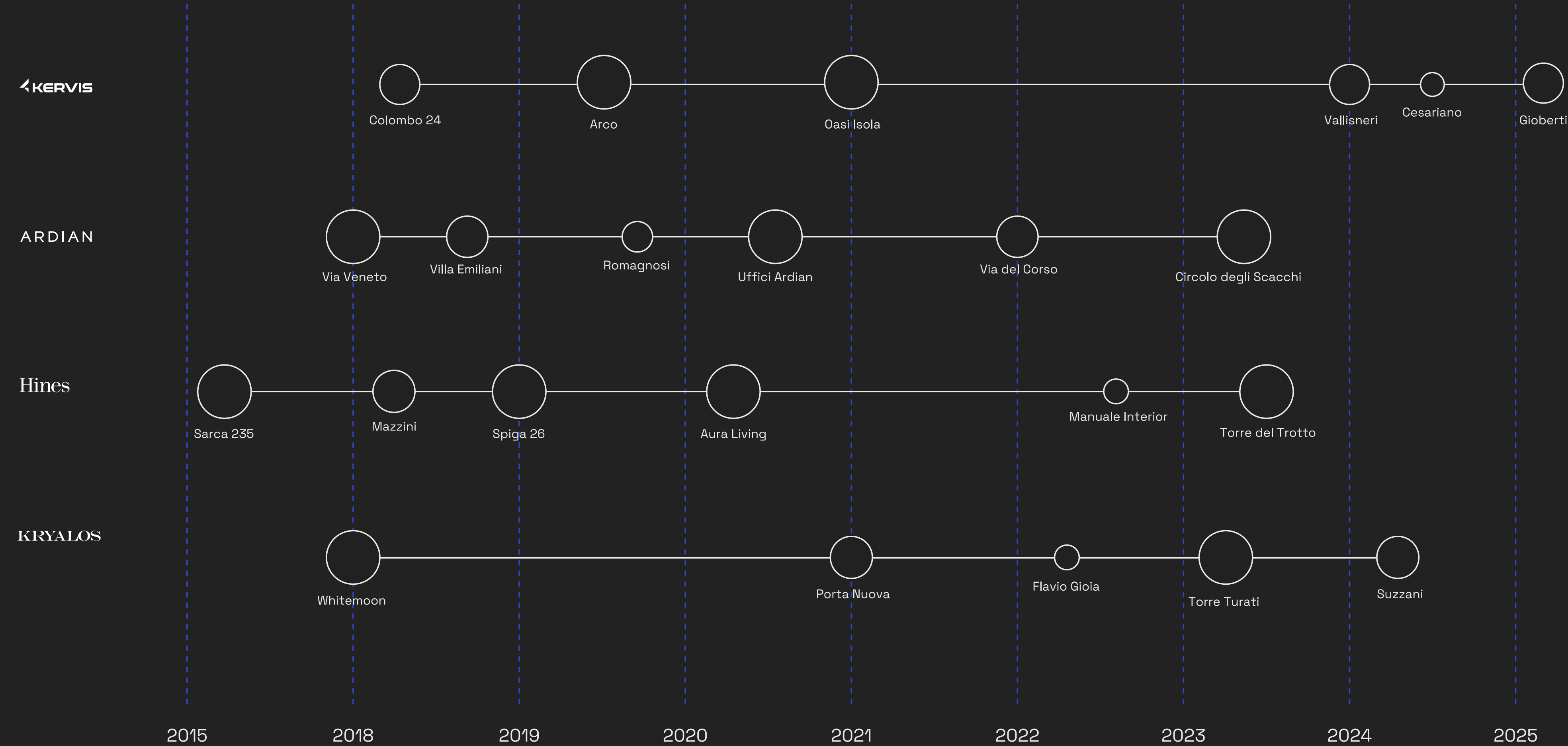
We boast a portfolio of predominantly private clients, from residential developments to retail, offices, and product design.

Additionally, we are always open to collaborations with external companies that can offer new perspectives on the future of living and spaces.

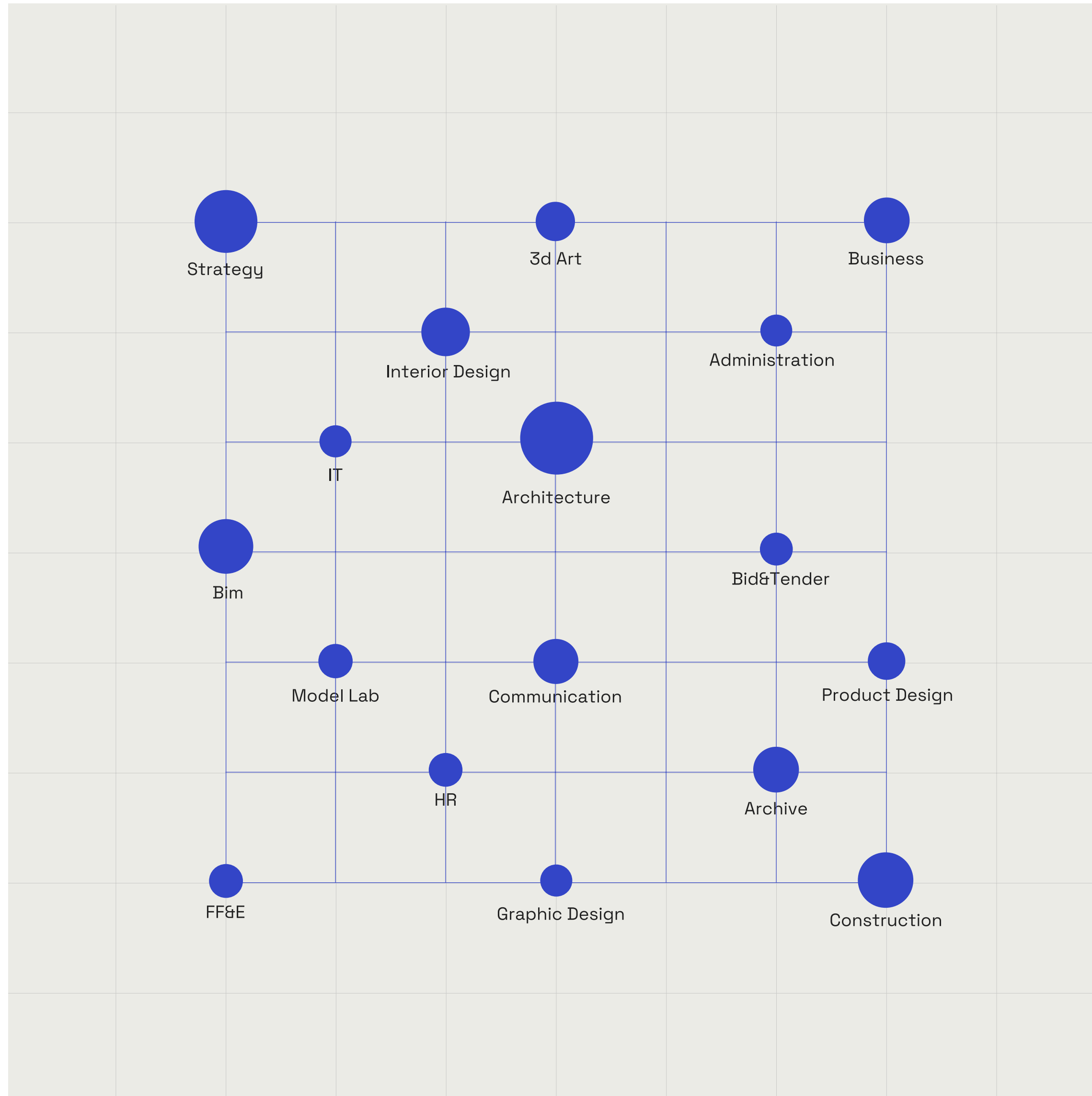


C3. Structure /

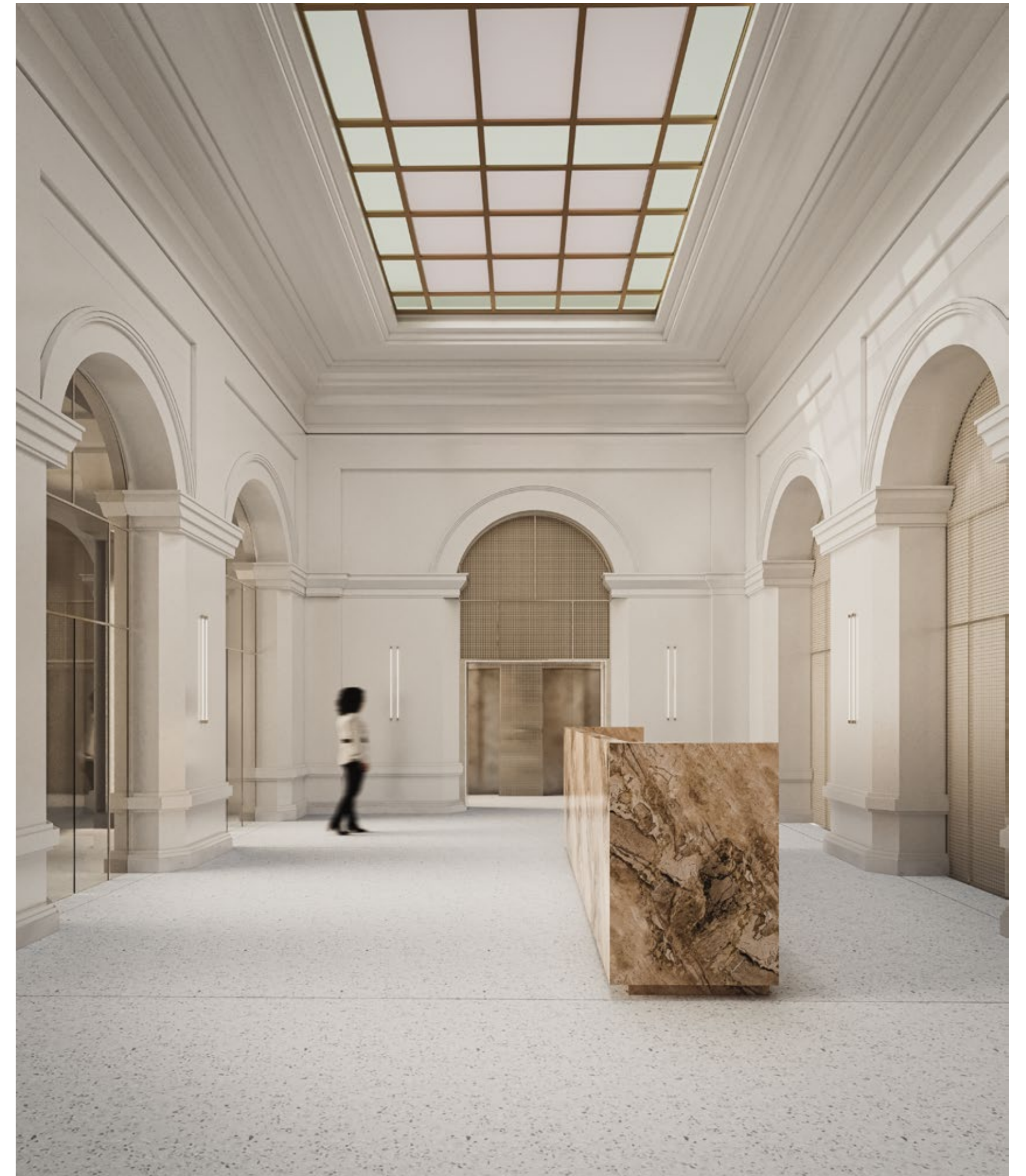


D. Methodology /

The studio has always worked across various project domains, from products to urban design.

The common approach across all scales of intervention starts with a method focused on recovering the memory and culture of design, drawing inspiration from the past. It follows a tailored attention to detail, transforming those references into concrete responses to present needs, with a design process that is always mindful of the impacts and human experience within the environment-space.

Our method combines research and construction, integrating interdisciplinary knowledge so that each project can introduce new themes, new insights, and new memories for the future.



D1. The importance of research /

Backstage is the research and development department of Scandurra Studio, established to analyze contemporary environmental, social, and technological shifts and translate them into design models for urban and living spaces. With two decades of experience, it brings together architects, researchers, and external partners in applied research across three main areas: **design methods, systems and materials, and social models.**

Functioning as a critical infrastructure integrated into the studio's practice, Backstage investigates emerging tools, sustainable construction, and new forms of living, generating concrete outputs that fuel design thinking and contribute to the architectural discourse.

The final design takes shape as a sensitive intervention, reinterpreting the traces of the past and opening a new direction for the future.



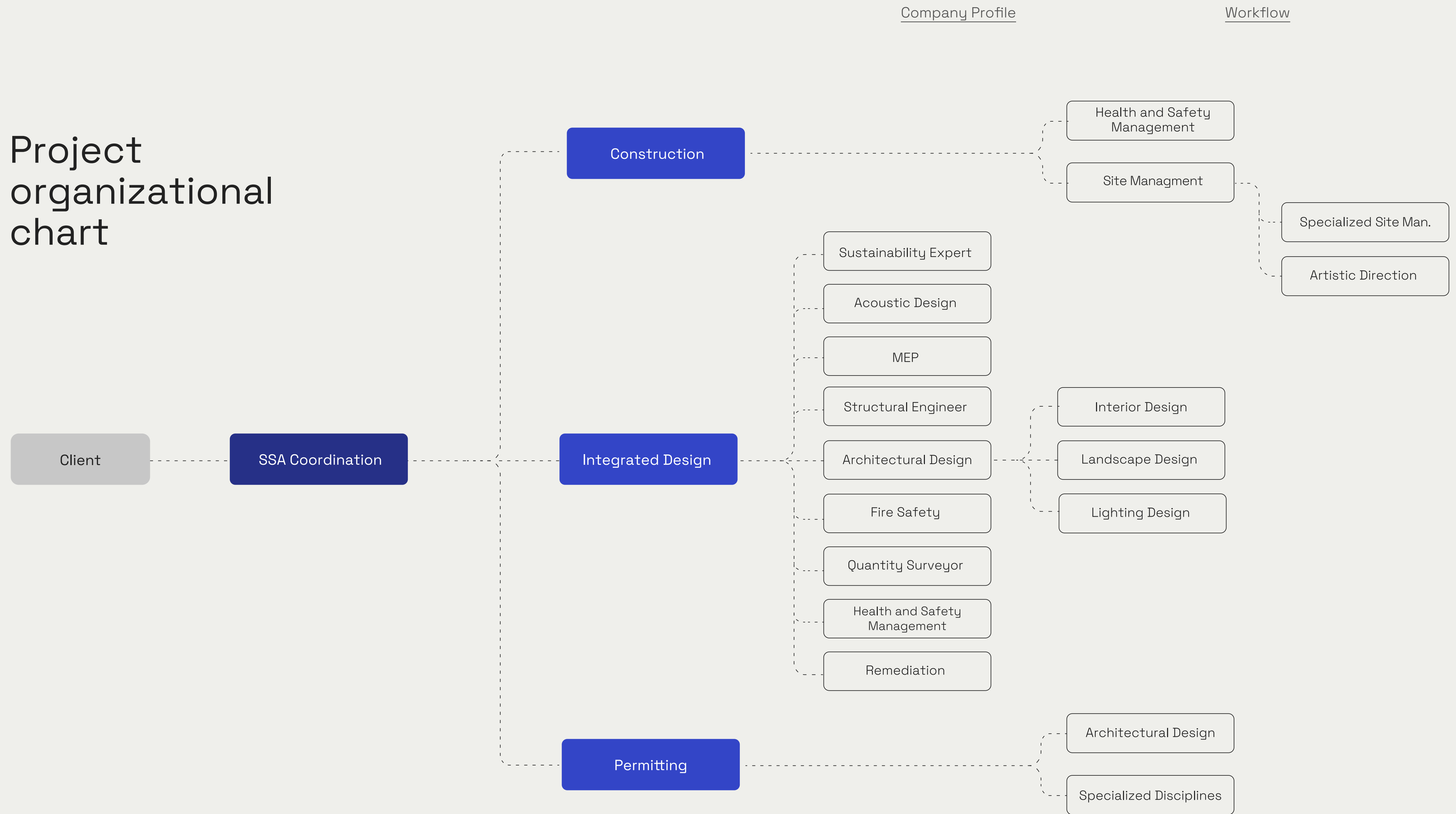
D1. Workflow /

Scandurra Studio integrates the challenge of digital transformation into every aspect of its work. The team operates efficiently in an agile environment in terms of processes and workflows, using cutting-edge tools for both the creative process and organizational structure.

To optimize workflows and facilitate agile collaboration, we adopt advanced methodologies such as BIM (Building Information Modeling) and RIBA (Royal Institute of British Architects) guidelines for process organization.

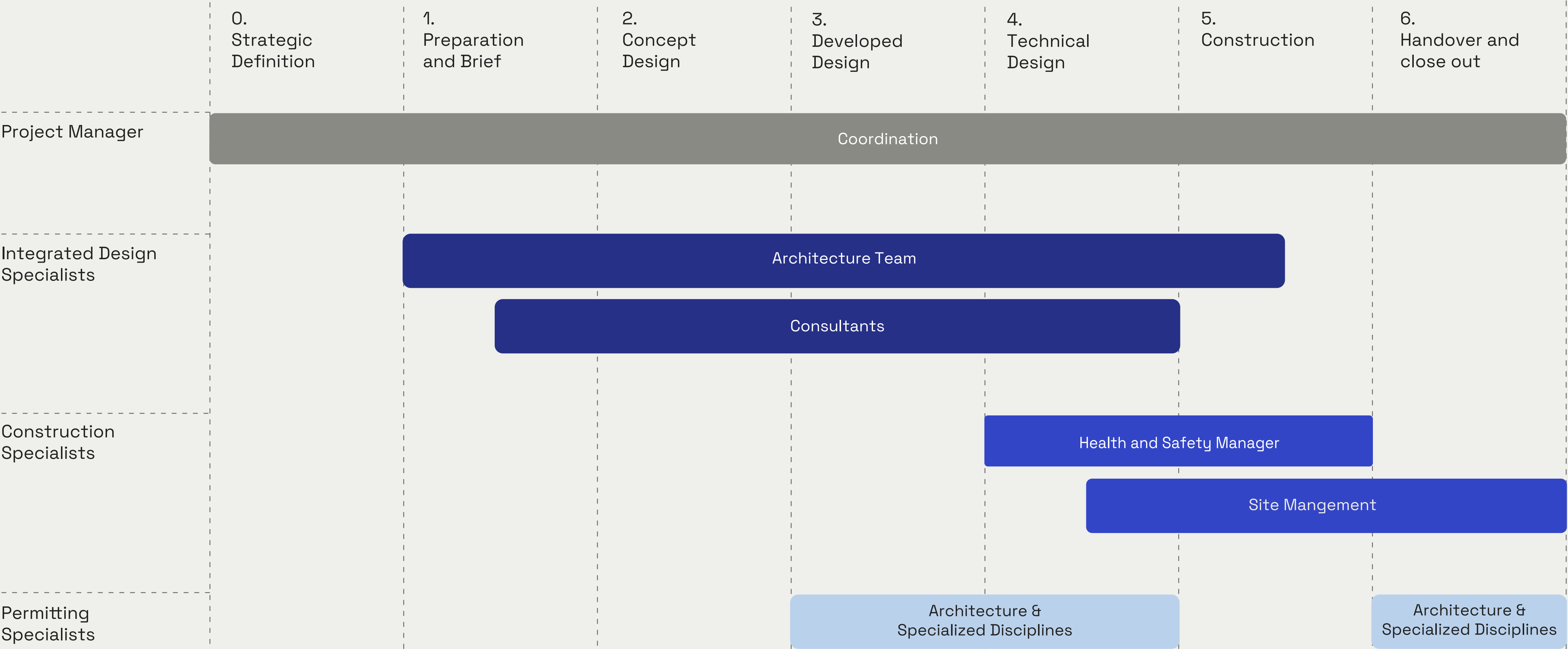
These tools allow us to effectively coordinate the various design phases, improving precision and quality of results while ensuring maximum efficiency in the process.

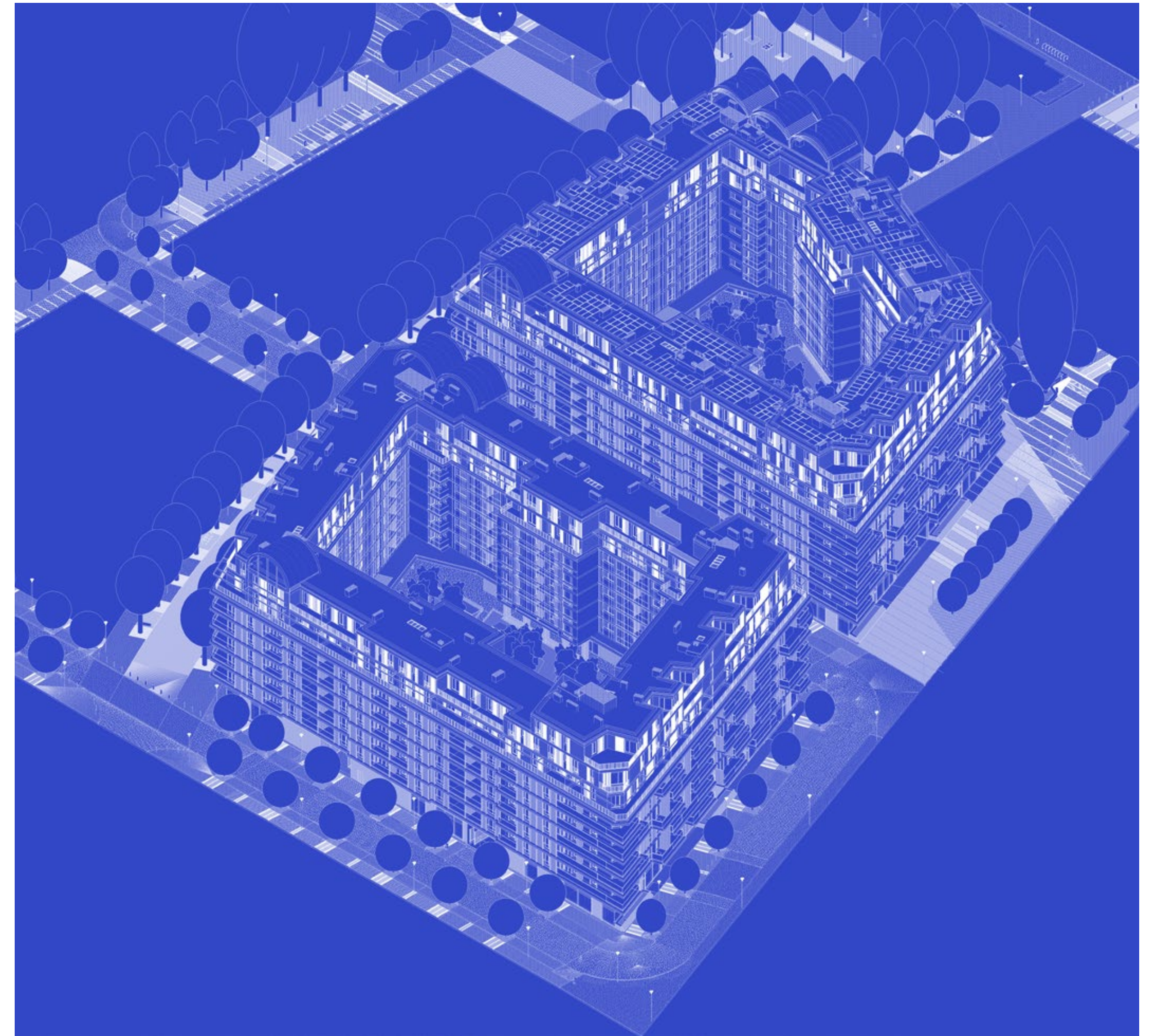


D4. Building Information Modeling (BIM) /

Building Information Modelling (BIM) is the standard method used by our firm, developed since the Cascina Merlata project in 2016.

We have an in-house dedicated team led by a BIM Manager, who ensures the quality of our projects. BIM Coordinators oversee individual projects, ensuring compliance with internal standards and proper coordination.

The BIM method is offered to clients for efficient project design, with data sharing through a Common Data Environment (CDE), keeping all stakeholders updated and ensuring seamless coordination.





D5. Business compliance /

At Scandurra Studio, the digitalization of processes is a central theme, and we are committed to adhering to the highest standards of security and IT efficiency.

We utilize an advanced IT infrastructure based on Syneto and an integrated storage system with disaster recovery capabilities, ensuring maximum security while providing efficient access to internal resources.

D6. Studio sustainability /

We actively promote environmental sustainability by adopting responsible practices.

One of our key choices is the use of electricity generated entirely from renewable sources, 100% produced in Italy. Complementing this approach, we have eliminated the use of gas, significantly reducing CO2 emissions.

A filtered potable water dispenser has allowed us to eliminate the use of plastic bottles. Finally, the D.A.L.I. lighting system ensures optimal energy use, adapting to the needs of each space and improving comfort through dedicated sensors, all with a focus on efficiency and environmental respect.







E. Projects /

The projects we undertake span from product design to urban development, with each reflecting the principles that drive our design culture.

Every project we deliver is the result of a rigorous and coherent process, built on values that are fundamental to us. These values not only define the identity of our work but also guide its direction and vision.

Central to our approach is our commitment to researching memory—both as the recovery and construction of a shared collective imagery and as the study of how materials evolve over time.

This reflection allows us to design with awareness, creating spaces for the community that are built to endure.

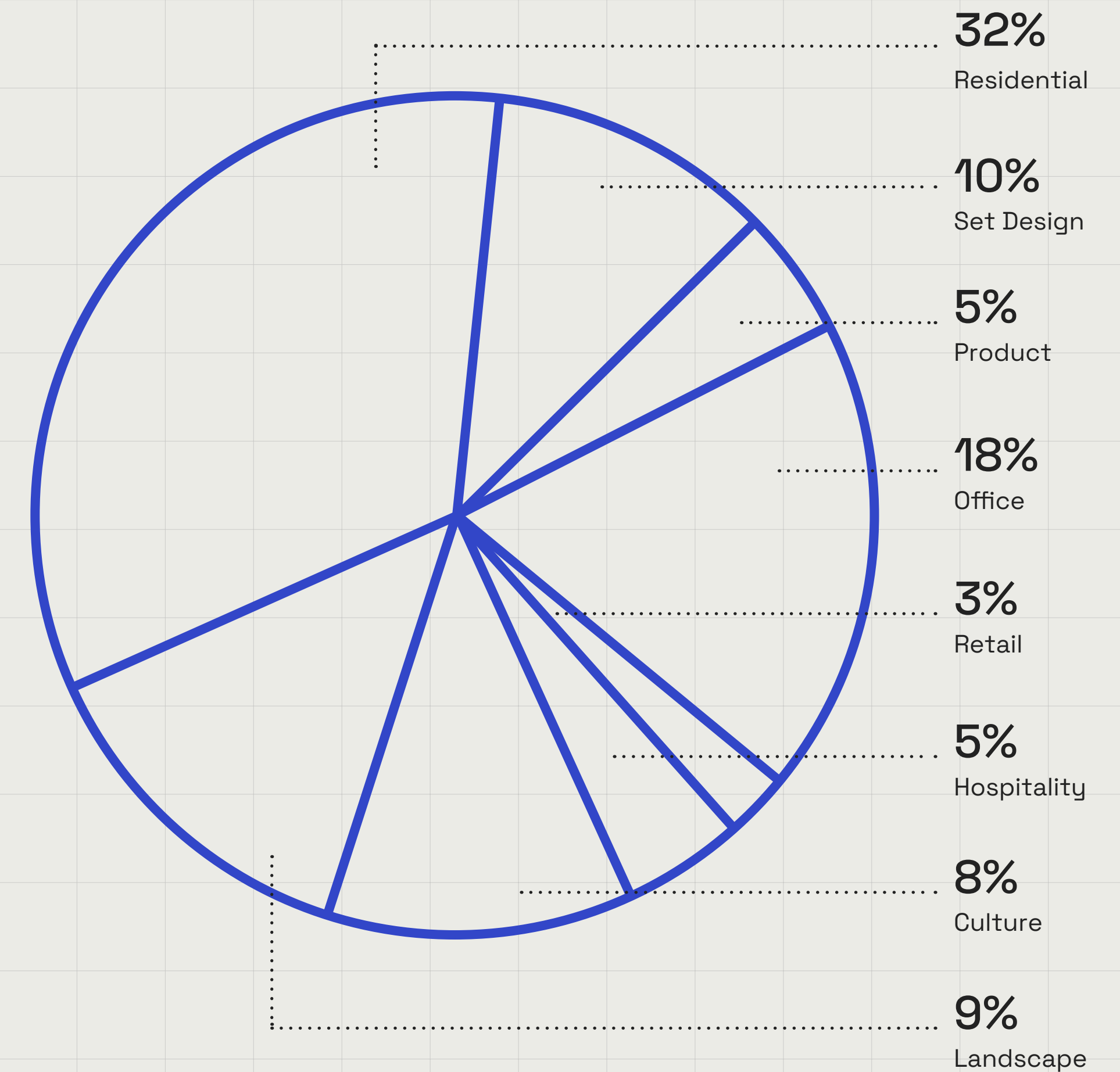
The Architecture and Design field, the studio's core business, diversifies into various segments, creating a very broad portfolio of proposals in the market.

Adjacent to Scalo Farini, Torre Futura, with its 23 floors, is situated near the upcoming transformation of the former railway area into an urban park.

Designed to connect the Cenisio neighborhood with the surrounding urban void, the tower stands out for its base, which interacts with the area’s spontaneous vegetation. The horizontal volumes, accentuated by protruding slabs, open the living spaces to the city, highlighting the hybrid character of the former railway yards.

The renovation project reorganized the internal circulation of the existing building and evoked the grandeur of Palazzo Pertusati, the neoclassical residence by architect Simone Cantoni, destroyed during WWII. The solutions recovered the site’s historical character while improving the building, confirmed by the LEED Gold Core&Shell certification.

The proposal transforms the Via della Spiga facade into a new iconic front. To reconnect with the city, the ground floor was brought to street level, opening 18 windows onto Via della Spiga.

The project, consisting of two pavilions and a central event space, was conceived as a device in continuous transformation.

Expo Gate merges a square and two steel-and-glass pavilions, framing the Castello Sforzesco, creating both a physical and digital access point to Expo, while also serving as a stage for events and public life.

A masterplan in the industrial port of Beijing, where a district dedicated to leisure, commerce, and residential living is being developed.

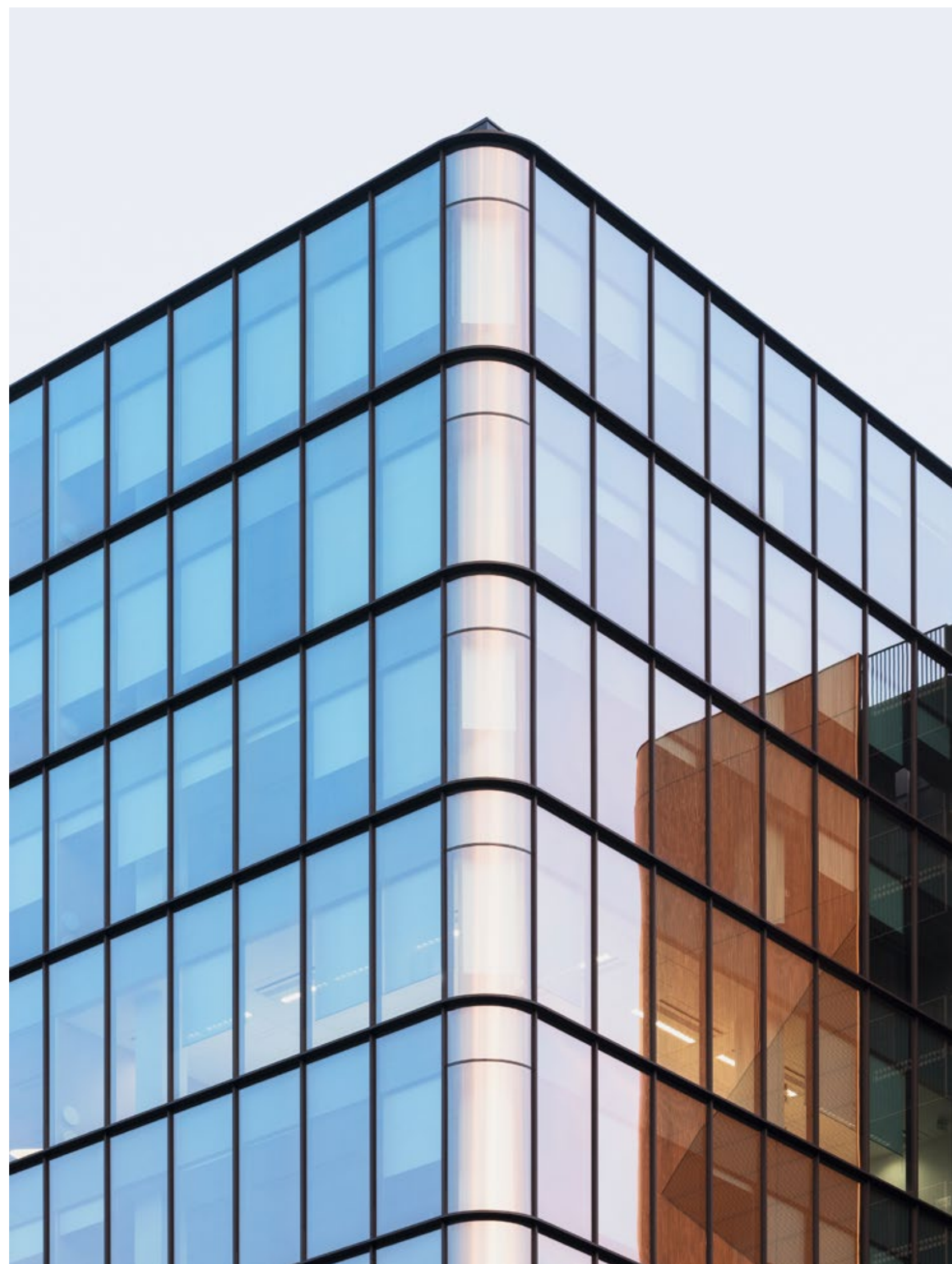
